

Below is a typical e-mail from a likely scammer. The name is extremely American, but the English is not good. They are promising a 3rd party cashier's check. And they are sending a shipper to pick up the object rather than have it mailed. All these are signs of a probable scammer.

Subject: RE: Payment...Kindly get back asap

My client who is owing me has promised to issue a cashier's check to whichever name I want to be on the check. The check will clear before my shipper will arrive your location to pick up the item.

Do get back to me with your details as requested so that payment can be made out and sent.
